  - AHCCCS eligibility, Pima Community Access Program (PCAP), WIC, screening for a variety of programs through Health-e-Arizona, patient advocacy and transportation services for patients.

- For more than 41 years, El Rio has continuously provided high-quality primary healthcare to thousands of patients annually.
- Diversified funding base:
  - Insurance, State, Federal and donations.
- We employ more than 800 people doctors, dentists, pharmacists, nurses, other medical staff and administrators.
- An operational budget over \$82 million annually.



- Over 311,000 medical and dental visits per year.




