system. A very unique icon on the site is the "quick exit button" which lets the reader quickly move to another site if their abuser enters the room.

The website will also serve as a resource for the latest research, trends and news about domestic violence. And for those who are interested in volunteering their time, or donating funds, there is a section of the site that offers information on how to do that.
