SERVING THE UNDERSERVED

InterCare Community Health Network is part of America's health care safety network that serves nearly 16 million people across the country each year.

InterCare was formed in 1972 to provide basic health care services in underserved communities. We are located in the heart of Southwest Michigan's fruit and vegetable belt and serve 40,000 residents and migrant farmworkers each year.

InterCare is supported in part with "Community and Migrant Health Center" grant funds from the federal Public Health Service and is a member of the National Association of Community Health Centers (NACHC) and the Michigan Primary Care Association (MPCA).

SLIDING FEE PROGRAM

InterCare's "sliding fee" program helps patients receive medical and dental services at our health centers at less cost. This is made possible by a federal grant. If qualified for InterCare's sliding fee program, patients pay a flat fee or a percent of their charges. Eligibility for the program is based on family size and income and is open to all who complete a form and provide proof of income.



The federal Medicare program says that community and migrant health centers like InterCare may also offer sliding fees to Medicare patients to help pay for any co-payments and deductibles not covered by Medicare.

InterCare Community Health Network accepts most insurances.
