MEDICAL HOME:

- Common Illnesses (fever, flu sore throats, coughs)
- Infections
- Asthma
- Vomiting

- Bleeding that won't stop
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Serious car accident
- Convulsion that lasts more than 3 minutes
- Pain or pressure in chest or upper stomach
