




# Care for the Homeless

- CFH provides services to homeless men, women and children in New York City by sending teams of doctors, nurses and social workers to outreach sites.
- CFH outreach sites include licensed medical clinics in soup kitchens, drop-in centers and shelters, as well as street outreach teams in Brooklyn, Queens, Manhattan and the Bronx.
- In 2010, CFH served 9,298 homeless men, women and children.
