

Services

Health Educators are trained to provide individualized education on various topics such as diabetes, hypertension, asthma, family planning, weight management, and poison control prevention.

Patient Navigators Program focuses on chronic disease management and intervention services by identifying a patient's current health status and working to encourage behavior changes and medical treatment compliance. Through its robust patient tracking, education, and follow-up system, the Patient Navigator Program is designed to improve care management practices and prevent disease and the further deterioration of chronic conditions.

- **Cancer Detection Program (CDP)** provides free annual clinical breast exams, mammograms, cervical cancer screening, and case management to qualified women over forty.

- **Diabetes Services** provides case management and patient education.

Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program provides education about important issues concerning your pregnancy from conception to birth, including nutrition and psycho-social concerns. Certified Childbirth Educators and Certified Passenger Safety Educators are also available.

Health Insurance Assistance Program (HIAP) helps individual and families who are uninsured apply for no cost or low cost health insurance coverage and provides case management services to newly insured individuals to help them understand and use their insurance benefits and keep and renew their coverage. HIAP also helps individuals and families apply for CalFresh (food stamps). Visit any of our health centers to apply today!

To apply for health insurance and/or CalFresh, please bring the following:

- ✓ **Photo Identification** for the person completing the application
- ✓ **Proof of ALL income** earned/received by EACH member of your household in the last 45 days (paycheck stubs, income tax statement, benefits award letter, letter from your employer, etc.)
- ✓ **Social Security Card** for each person requesting benefits, *if available*
- ✓ **Birth Certificate, U.S. Passport, U.S. Resident Card,** or any other document that verifies current immigration status for each person requesting benefits, *if available*



Women, Infants & Children (WIC)

Operating 25 WIC locations throughout Kern County

Sixth largest program in the State of California (42,000+ clients per month)

WIC provides nutrition education, breastfeeding support and food vouchers for pregnant and post-partum women, infants and children up to five years of age.

HIV/AIDS

We provide specialized infectious disease and primary care services to HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis C patients.

Kern Lifeline Project: Case management services, individual and small group behavioral health counseling, advocacy and emergency assistance to people with HIV/AIDS and their families

Clinica Sierra Vista offers confidential and anonymous HIV testing, as well as education and prevention services for the general public, especially targeting at-risk populations.



Family Services, Adolescent Services & Health Promotion

Black Infant Health (BIH): Comprehensive, community-based effort to reduce infant mortality by serving at-risk pregnant and parenting African-American women and assuring that they have access to maternal and child health services

Differential Response: Links families to any service that might be needed to prevent child abuse and neglect

Family Resource Center: Neighborhood-based services utilizing case management, home visitation, and multidisciplinary team conferences, located in Ridgecrest and Southeast Bakersfield

Health Insurance Assistance Program/Medi-Cal: Facilitate applications for people who are uninsured or need to be recertified

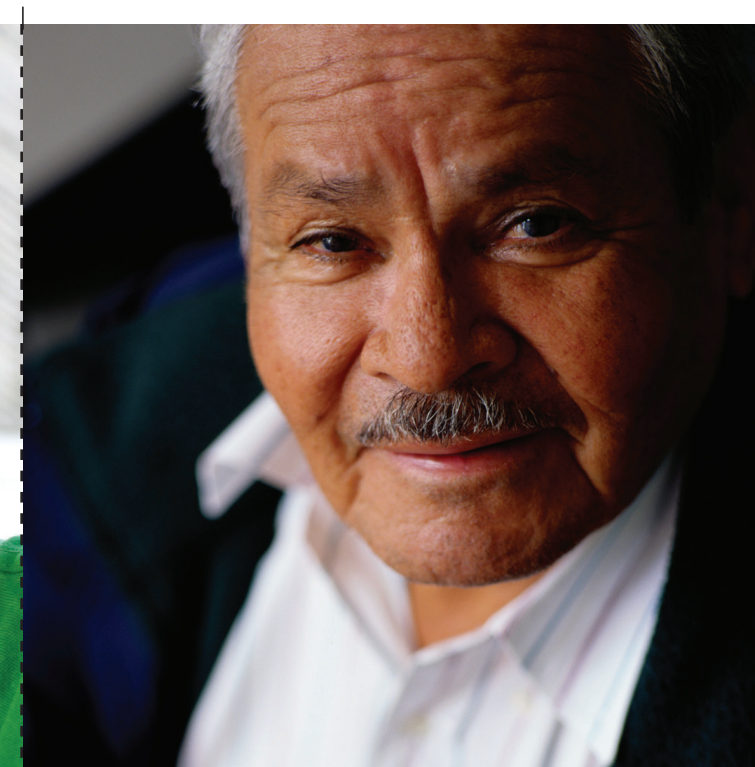

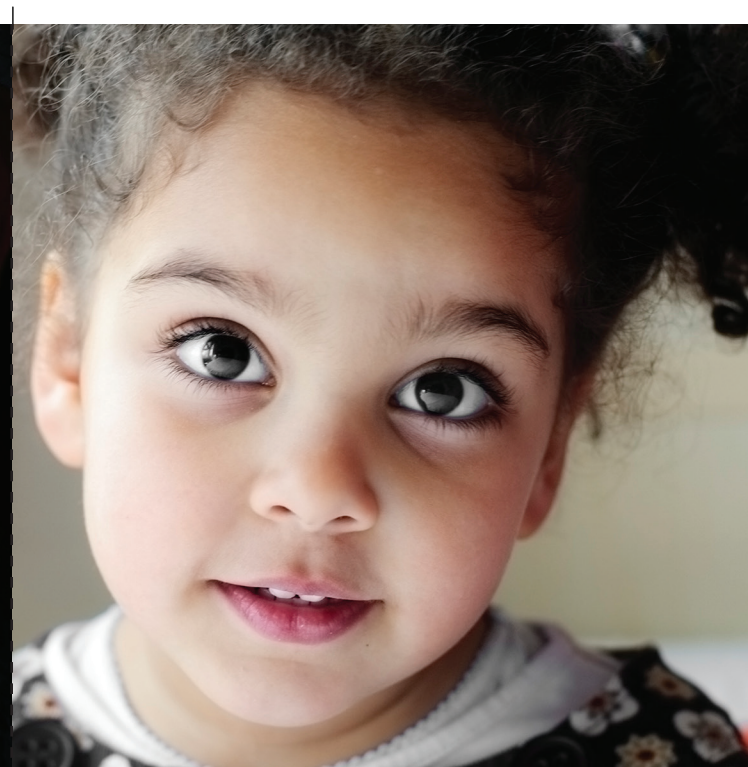

Becoming a Patient

What to Bring with You When visiting a health center you will need to bring:

1. Proper identification (photo ID, birth certificate, or any other document that verifies who you are)
2. Current Health Insurance Card(s) (Medi-Cal BIC, private health insurance, etc.)

Uninsured For the uninsured, we accept payment using a sliding fee scale based on household income and family size. To be considered for the Sliding Fee Program, please bring proper identification and proof of ALL income earned/received by EACH member of your household in the last 30 days (paycheck stubs, income tax statement, benefits award letter, letter from your employer, etc.)

Making Appointments You can make an appointment by calling the health center you wish to visit. Hours vary by location; please call the health center to confirm hours and days of operation.

Insurance We accept Medi-Cal, Medicare, private insurances, most HMO plans and cash. We have Certified Enrollment Counselors in our health centers who will help you apply for no cost or low cost health insurance coverage.

Same-Day Appointments (Walk-ins) We accept same-day appointments at all of our health centers. Please keep in mind that your wait time may be longer since patients with scheduled appointments will be seen first.
