

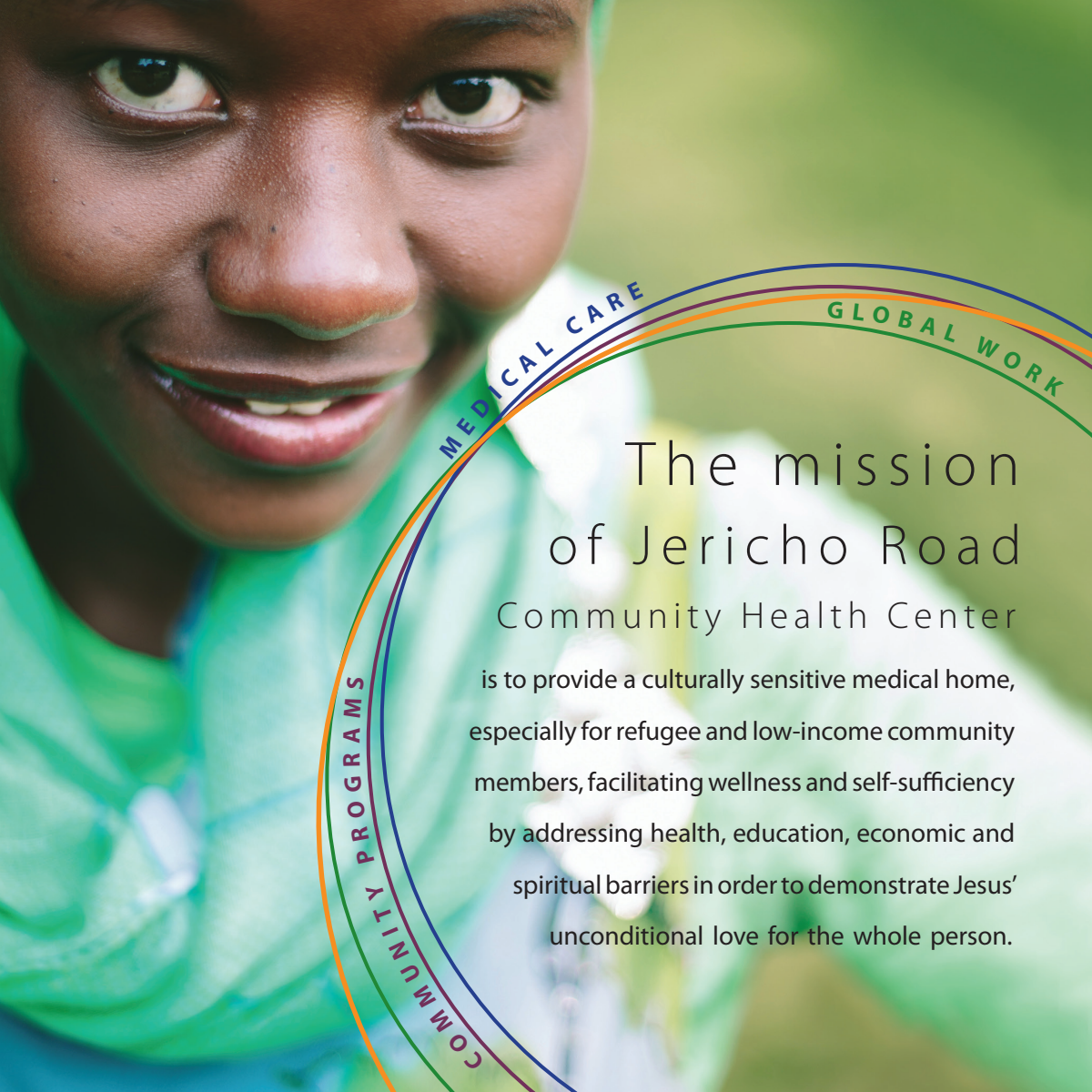

The mission
of Jericho Road
Community Health Center
is to provide a culturally sensitive medical home,
especially for refugee and low-income community
members, facilitating wellness and self-sufficiency
by addressing health, education, economic and
spiritual barriers in order to demonstrate Jesus'
unconditional love for the whole person.

Jericho Road provides high-quality medical care for the whole family — especially those with limited access to medical care — families in poverty, refugees, and immigrants. We provide full-spectrum care to all, even individuals without insurance or the ability to pay. Jericho Road seeks not only to treat, but also empower our patients, and we have attained Level 3 Recognition as a Patient-Centered Medical Home by the National Committee for Quality Assurance.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS



In addition to medical care, Jericho Road has developed a wide array of community development programs, seeking to address the needs of those we serve more holistically. We engage a very diverse staff that aptly represents the ethnicities we serve, forming a bridge of trust within Buffalo's ethnic communities. Our support services range from mentoring and doula assistance for at-risk, pregnant refugee women to legal services for asylum seekers in the United States and Canada.

OUR COMMUNITY PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

- VIVE: legal services and temporary housing for asylum seekers
- HOPE REFUGEE DROP-IN CENTER: client driven help center for refugees
- PRISCILLA PROJECT: mentoring of at-risk, pregnant refugee women
- ESL INITIATIVE: English classes for adult learners
- PARENT CHILD HOME PROGRAM: in-home early childhood development
- POLLY PROJECT: mentoring of economically disadvantaged women
- FINANCIALLY FIT: financial education and planning for families





Jericho Road's global health outreach tangibly demonstrates the love of God through medical missions addressing health disparities in the home countries of our refugee patients. Currently our global health outreach operates in:

KONO DISTRICT, SIERRA LEONE: Jericho Road's Adama Martha Memorial Community Health Center (AMMCHC) opened in February 2015, in the midst of the worst Ebola outbreak the world had ever seen. AMMCHC offers both inpatient and outpatient services in a



23 room facility that includes 5 exam rooms, a screening and triage area, a laboratory, a pharmacy, a birthing suite, and 11 inpatient beds. The center also conducts medical outreach to remote villages and community health training to promote healthy living.

GOMA, DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO (DRC): Jericho Road's Wellness Clinic at New Hope Center opened December 2016 and seeks to improve healthcare for the most vulnerable individuals in Goma, especially orphans, traumatized children, and widows and their children, who would otherwise have no access to primary care.

The Wellness Center provides primary health care, prenatal and maternity care, health education, spiritual care and family planning services. Jericho Road works very closely with New Hope Center for Grieving Children in providing holistic care to orphaned patients.
