The site houses three exam rooms and one treatment room. The 2,000 square foot facility is open five days a week, eight hours per day.

Access is the Answer Campaign

The Fiscal Cliff for Community Health Centers is nearing - We NEED your Support... Contact Our Members of Congress TODAY!

On March 19th, a group of from CSV meet with our Congressional Leaders in Washington D.C. to discuss the very issues that you have been advocating for: (1) Health Center Funding Cliff; (2) Teaching Health Center program; and (3) National Health Services Corps.

We met with representatives from Congressman Kevin McCarthy, Congressman Paul Cook, and Congressman Valadao's offices, and had an opportunity to meet with our long-standing supporter, Congressman Jim Costa.

Last week, the **House** passed a historic piece of legislation which, thanks to your advocacy, included continued Health Center Funding at its current level for two years. An overwhelming bipartisan majority voted in favor of the bill, with 392 votes in favor of the SGR "doc fix" bill, H.R. 2. In addition to \$7.2 billion in mandatory funding over two years for Health Centers, the bill continues funding for the National Health Service Corps and the Teaching Health Centers Program for two years.

The **Senate** still needs to vote to pass this legislation in order for it to become law and for us to move closer to a fix for the Health Center Funding Cliff. The Senate, however, has recessed for two weeks and will not vote on H.R. 2 until they return on April 13th.

This gives you and every other **Advocate** a great opportunity to let your Senators know that you want them to "Vote Yes on H.R. 2" when they return to Washington. We need to do everything we can over the next two weeks to get a commitment to vote "yes" from each Senator.

Thank you again for your incredible advocacy. We have a lot of work left to do, and we continue to count on your advocacy to make sure we see an overwhelming "yes" vote in the Senate.
