The major problem this project is concerned with is the lack of educational development which prevents migrant and seasonal farm workers youth from obtaining gainful, non-farm employment.

## OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

The objective is to provide an educational program which will provide the necessary instruction so that a General Educational Development (GED) certificate can be obtained. After passing the GED, students are placed in jobs with potential for growth, vocational or job training, or in higher education programs.

The long range objective is to open new avenues of upward mobility for these Migrant youth who because of prior limited academic education had no recourse other than deadend migrant labor.
